SWANENG BOARD OF GOVERNORS (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1971

(Published on the 16th April, 1971)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Education Law, 1966 the Minister of Education has made the following order –

- Citation **1.** This order may be cited as the Swaneng Board of Governors (Amendment) Order, 1971.
- Amendment of paragraph 3 of S.I. 69/1970 **2.** Paragraph 3 of the Swaneng Board of Governors Order, 1970 (hereinafter called the principal order) is amended –
- (i) by the deletion of the fullstop at the end of subparagraph (b) and the substitution therefor of a semi-colon; and
 - (ii) by the addition immediately after subparagraph (b) of the following new subparagraph –
“(c) Madiba School, Mahalapye, Madiba Builders’ Brigade, Madiba Textile Workshop, Madiba Farmers’ Brigade and Madiba Carpenters’ Brigade.”
- Amendment of paragraph 10 of the principal order **3.** Paragraph 10 of the principal order is amended –
- (i) by the addition, immediately after subparagraph (a) of the following new subparagraph –
“(b) the vice-chairman of the Board who shall be the Vice-Chairman of the Executive Committee;” and
 - (ii) by the renumbering of present subparagraphs (b), (c), (d) and (e) as subparagraphs (c), (d), (e) and (f).
- Amendment of paragraph 11 of the principal order **4.** Paragraph 11 of the principal order is amended by the addition, immediately after subparagraph (15), of the following new subparagraph –
- “(16) The Board shall have power to purchase, hold or manage any land or interest in or right over land, and sell, lease or otherwise dispose of any land or interest in or right over land owned by the Board upon such conditions as the Board may determine, including, in the case of a sale by the Board, conditions as to payment of the price upon deferred terms.”
