### **AN ACT TO AUTHORISE THE PAYMENT OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND AND THE DEVELOPMENT FUND OF SUMS OF MONEY FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING ON THE 31ST MARCH, 1973.**

*Date of Commencement:* 30.3.1972

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (1972/1973) Act, 1972. Short title

**2.** The Minister of Finance and Development Planning may issue a warrant for the payment from the Consolidated Fund for the financial year ending on the 31st March, 1973, of the sum of R21,265,057 (twenty-one million two hundred and sixty-five thousand and fifty-seven rand). Expenditure

Appropriation      **3.** The sum authorised by section 2 is appropriated to and shall be applied for the purposes of the heads of expenditure set out in the first and second columns of the First Schedule, in the amounts set opposite thereto in the third column of that Schedule.

Expenditure from Development Fund      **4.** The Minister of Finance and Development Planning may issue a warrant for the payment from the Development Fund for the financial year ending on the 31st March, 1973, of the sum of R45,245,858 (forty-five million two hundred and forty-five thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight rand).

Appropriation      **5.** The sum authorised by section 4 is appropriated to and shall be applied for the purposes of the heads of expenditure set out in the first and second columns of the Second Schedule, in the amounts set opposite thereto in the third column of that Schedule.
