AN ACT TO AMEND THE JUDGES (SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES) ACT 1968

Date of Assent: 30.5.1972.

Date of Commencement:

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the Judges (Salaries and Allowances) (Amendment) Act, 1972, and shall be read and construed as one with the Judges (Salaries and Allowances) Act, 1968, hereinafter referred to as the principal law.

Short title

2. Section 3 (2) of the principal law is amended as follows —

(i) by the deletion of the letter and figures "R100" appearing in paragraph (a) thereof and by the substitution therefor of the letter and figures "R150"; and

(ii) by the deletion of the letter and figures "R30" appearing in paragraph (b) thereof and by the substitution therefor of the letter and figures "R50".

3. (1) Section 4 (b) of the principal law is amended as follows—

(i) by the deletion of the words "Overseas Service (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Agreement, 1962" appearing therein and by the substitution therefor of the words "Overseas Service (Botswana) Agreement, 1970"; and

- (ii) by the deletion of the letter and figures "R681" appearing therein and by the substitution therefor of the letter and figures "R1,362".

(2) Section 4 (d) of the principal law is amended by the deletion of the letter and figures "R400" appearing therein and by the substitution therefor of the letter and figures "R600".

4. Section 5 (b) of the principal law is amended as follows —

- (i) by the deletion of the words "Overseas Service (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Agreement, 1962" appearing therein and by the substitution therefor of the words "Overseas Service (Botswana) Agreement, 1970"; and
- (ii) by the deletion of the letter and figures "R603" appearing therein and by the substitution therefor of the letter and figures "R1,206".
