**THE ABOLITION OF PUBLIC OFFICE (DIRECTOR
OF EDUCATION) ORDER, 1972**

(Published on the 17th March, 1972)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon him by section 24A of the Interpretation and General Provisions Law, 1966, and of all other powers thereunto him enabling, His Excellency the President makes the following order —

1. This Order may be cited as the Abolition of Public Office (Director of Education) Order, 1972.
2. The office of Director of Education is hereby abolished. Abolition

3. All functions vested under any law in the Director of Education shall, with effect from the date of this Order, vest in the Chief Education Officer. Vesting of
