**MOTOR VEHICLE AND ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS,
1972**

(Published on the 14th January, 1972)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 54 of the Motor Vehicle and Road Traffic Proclamation, His Excellency the President has made the following regulations ---

Citation **1.** These regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicle and Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1972.

Amendment of Notice 84/1947 **2.** The Motor Vehicle and Road Traffic Regulations are amended by the addition immediately after regulation 30 of the following new regulation -

“Right of way at certain road junctions

31. The driver of a vehicle on a public road shall, when he intends entering any portion of a public road which constitutes a junction of two or more public roads where vehicular traffic is required to move round a traffic island within such junction, yield the right of way to all vehicular traffic approaching from his right within such junction, unless his entry into such junction is controlled by an instruction given by a police officer or a direction conveyed by a road traffic sign requiring him to act differently.”
