NOTICE OF ADOPTION BY NORTH WEST DISTRICT COUNCIL

(Published on the 14th April, 1972)

IN EXERCISE of the powers vested in it by section 36 of the Local Government (District Councils) Law, 1965, the North West District Council has adopted the Dogs (Model) Bye-Laws, 1971, as bye-laws of the said North West District Council to be applied within the area of its jurisdiction with effect from the date of publication of this notice with the variation set out in paragraph 2 of this notice.

2. Bye-law 9 of the said bye-laws in its application in the area of jurisdiction of the North West District Council shall read as follows —

“9. Any person who fails to comply with these bye-laws shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of R10 or, in default thereof, to imprisonment for one month.”.
