REMOVALS FROM CERTAIN JUDICIAL OFFICES AND  
THE EXERCISE OF POWERS OF DISCIPLINE IN RESPECT

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Judicial Offices (Powers of Appointment, Discipline and Removal) Act, 1973. Short title

**2.** Where, for the purpose of section 105 (2) of the Constitution, the President, by notice published in the Gazette, prescribes any judicial office or any office connected with any court for which a legal qualification is necessary or desirable, the power to appoint any person to hold or act in such office, to exercise disciplinary control over any person holding or acting in such office, and to remove such person from office, shall vest in the President acting in accordance with the advice of the Judicial Service Commission.
