**5. The Schedule is amended by substituting for paragraph 4 thereof the new paragraph following —**

**4. Every member other than a Minister or Assistant Minister shall receive an allowance, calculated as follows**

(a) for a member representing one of the following constituencies —

Serowe South  
Mochudi  
Molepolole  
Kanye South

at the rate of R108 per annum

(b) for a member representing one of the following constituencies —

Francistown and Tati East  
Nkange  
Tonota  
Mmadinare  
Tswapong North  
Mahalapye  
Kgatleng and Tlokweng  
Molepolole East  
Kweneng South  
Gaborone and Ramotswa  
Moshupa  
Kanye North  
Lobatse/Barolong

at the rate of R180 per annum;

(c) for a member representing one of the following constituencies —

Tati West  
Serowe North  
Tswapong South

at the rate of R240 per annum;

(d) for a member representing one of the following constituencies —

Sebina and Gweta  
Ngwaketse Kgalagadi

at the rate of R360 per annum;

(e) for a member representing one of the following constituencies —

Okavango  
Ngami  
Ghanzi  
Boteti

Bobirwa  
Shoshong

at the rate of R480 per annum;

(f) for a member representing one of the following constituencies —

Maun and Chobe  
Kweneng West

at the rate of R600 per annum;

(g) for the member representing the Kgalagadi constituency at the rate of R960 per annum;

(h) for a specially elected member at the rate of R180 per annum.”

6. The Schedule is amended by inserting at the end thereof the new paragraph following —

Termination allowance 6. (1) Subject to the provisions of subparagraphs (2), (3), (4) and (5), every member shall, on ceasing to be a member, receive a termination allowance at the rate of twenty per centum of the aggregate basic salary drawn by him while he was a member.

(2) No termination allowance shall be payable to a member who ceases to hold office by virtue of paragraph (b) or (c) of section 69 (1) of the Constitution.

(3) If a Minister or Assistant Minister ceases to hold office as such, that proportion of the allowance attributable to the difference between his salary as Minister, or Assistant Minister, as the case may be, and the salary paid to a member under paragraph 1 (f) of this Schedule may be withheld, in whole or in part, at the discretion of the President.

(4) A terminal allowance shall not be payable until a member ceases to hold office as a member and, for the purposes of this paragraph, a member's service shall not be deemed to cease on the dissolution of Parliament unless he is not re-elected.

(5) There shall be deducted from the terminal allowance payable to a member any sums due to Government.”
