AIR NAVIGATION ORDER, 1961

(S.I. 1961/2316)

CONTROL OF FLYING (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1973

(Published on the 21st December, 1973)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by article 77 of the Air Navigation Order, 1961, His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Flying Citation (Amendment) Regulations, 1973.

2. Regulation 7 (1) of the Control of Flying Regulations, 1965, is amended by adding at the end thereof the following proviso —

Provided that the provisions of this regulation shall not apply to a single-engined aircraft commanded by a pilot holding a private pilot's licence and who has at least 500 hours' flying experience or a pilot holding a commercial, senior commercial or airline transport pilot's licence and the aircraft is equipped with —

- (i) high frequency radio equipment capable of communicating with Johannesburg, Salisbury or Windhoek controls;
- (ii) very high frequency radio equipment crystal controlled through the frequency range of 118.1 MHZ to 136 MHZ;
- (iii) automatic radio direction finding equipment; and
- (iv) a survival location beacon capable of transmitting on 121.5 MHZ and 243 MHZ.
