**DECLARATION OF INFESTED WATERS
(CHOBE RIVER) ORDER, 1973**

(Published on the 31st August, 1973)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Aquatic Weeds (Control) Act, 1971, the Minister of Agriculture has made the following Order—

1. This Order may be cited as the Declaration of Infested Waters (Chobe River) Order, 1973. Citation

2. The surface waters within the area defined in the Schedule hereto are declared to be infested with aquatic weeds. Declaration of infested waters

SCHEDULE

That part of the river known as the Chobe, Linyanti or Linyote, commencing at a point where the international boundary between the Republic of Botswana and Rhodesia intersects the river in the proximity of the Kazungula Ferry and proceeding in a westerly and south westerly direction along the international boundary between the Republic of Botswana and the Caprivi Zipfel to a point on the river where the eastern boundary of the Batawana Tribal Territory intersects with the international boundary between the Republic of Botswana and the Caprivi Zipfel and all waters, seasonal or otherwise, within five miles of this portion of the Chobe, Linyanti or Linyote river.
