**THE FAUNA CONSERVATION PROCLAMATION, 1961**  
(22 of 1961)

**DECLARATION OF PRIVATE GAME RESERVES**

*(Published on the 27th July, 1973)*

IN EXERCISE of the powers vested in him by section 8 (1) of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961, His Excellency the President hereby declares the areas of land described in the Schedule to be Private Game Reserves for the protection and preservation therein of wild animal life, subject to the following conditions —

- (a) Persons authorised thereto in accordance with the provisions of section 16 read with section 9 of the said Proclamation may hunt game on the said land in accordance with the provisions of the said sections read with section 49 of the said Proclamation.
- (b) The holder of a Minister's licence granted under the provisions of section 31 of the aforesaid Proclamation, may hunt game on the said land in terms of section 9 of the aforesaid Proclamation.
