EXPORT CONTROL (SEMI-PRECIOUS STONES) NOTICE, 1973

(Published on the 12th January, 1973)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Exportation and Importation Restriction Proclamation, His Excellency the President has made the following Notice —

1. This Notice may be cited as the Export Control (Semi-Precious Stones) Notice, 1973. Citation

2. In this Notice — Inter-pretation
“Mining Commissioner” means the person appointed as such under section 4 of the Mines and Minerals Act, 1967; 50 of 1967

“semi-precious stones” means any substance declared to be a semi-precious stone under section 2 of the Mines and Minerals Act, 1967.

3. Subject to paragraph 4 no person shall export from Botswana any unworked semi-precious stones save under the authority of an export permit issued by the Mining Commissioner. Restriction on export of semi-precious stones

4. No permit shall be required for any one consignment of unworked semi-precious stones of a total weight of less than 20 kilograms exported by any one person in any calendar year for the purpose of sampling and which is declared to be exported for such purpose. Samples
