**BRITISH SOUTH AFRICA COMPANY LAND PROCLAMATION**  
(Cap. 114)

**PROCLAMATION**

*(Published on the 18th October, 1973)*

by His Excellency, Sir Seretse Khama, President of the Republic of Botswana

WHEREAS it appears to me that certain land, being land described in the Schedule hereto and situate in the Lobatse Block, is required for a public purpose, namely – the establishment and construction of a tannery, its ancillary buildings and works

AND WHEREAS such land is subject to the provisions of the British South Africa Company Land Proclamation

AND WHEREAS by section 8 of the said Proclamation I am empowered to take such land for such purpose

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the said powers I hereby take the land described in the Schedule hereto and declare the same to be vested in the Republic of Botswana as State Land.

**SCHEDULE**

That piece of land known as Portion 13 of the farm KNOCKDUFF 6-JO measuring 17,6760 (seventeen comma six seven six zero) morgen more particularly described and delineated on diagram number 5515/58 prepared in June, 1958, by surveyor S.L. MONCROFT, and approved by the Surveyor-General on 21st August, 1958, which diagram is held by the Director of Surveys, Gaborone, and which piece of land is presently held by H.D. Going under title deed number 88 of 1963, dated 25th November, 1963, as part of the Remaining Extent of the farm Knockduff 6-JO.
