REGULATION OF WAGES AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT ACT, 1969  
(22 of 1969)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Regulation of Wages and Conditions of Employment Act, 1969, the Minister of Health, Labour and Home Affairs hereby makes the following Order —

**THE REGULATION OF WAGES (HOTEL AND CATERING  
TRADES WAGES COUNCIL ESTABLISHMENT) ORDER, 1973**

1. This Order may be cited as the Regulation of Wages (Hotel and Catering Trades Wages Council Establishment) Order, 1973.

2. There is hereby established a Wages Council (to be known and hereinafter referred to as the Hotel and Catering Trades Wages Council) to perform, in relation to the employees specified in the Schedule to this Order, the powers and functions specified in that behalf in the Act.

3. The Hotel and Catering Trades Wages Council shall consist, as to independent members, of a Chairman, a Deputy Chairman and one other, and, as to representative members, of not more than two persons to represent employers, and not more than two persons to represent employees.

SCHEDULE

All persons employed in any undertaking or part of an undertaking which consists of the carrying on (whether for profit or not) of one or other of the following activities, that is to say, the supply of food or drink for immediate consumption or the provision of living accommodation for guests or lodgers:

Provided that persons employed in an undertaking or part of an undertaking which is operated by the Government, a charitable or religious organization, or by an educational or medical institution shall be excluded.

In this Schedule, "undertaking" includes any person, firm, business, company or club, and the activities of any body whether corporate or incorporate, whether carried on by way of trade or not.
