SHOP HOURS PROCLAMATION
(Cap. 158)

SHOP HOURS (SALES OF PETROL) NOTICE, 1973

(Published on the 16th November, 1973)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 5 (1) of the Shop Hours Proclamation, the Minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Notice —

1. This Notice may be cited as the Shop Hours (Sales of Petrol) Notice, 1973.

2. Shops in respect of which a petrol filling station licence has been issued under the Trading Act, 1966, and situate within the areas specified in the Schedule hereto may remain open for the sale of goods permitted to be sold under such licence at all times, within the discretion of the employer, other than between the hours of 6 p.m. on Saturday and 6 a.m. on the Monday following, and, notwithstanding the provisions of section 7 (2), any shop assistant may be employed for the sale of such goods at all such times as the shop may be open: 6 of 1966

Provided that the provisions of section 7 (1) shall continue to apply in respect of such shop assistant.

3. G.N. 56 of 1954 is amended accordingly.

SCHEDULE

Those areas within 10 miles of the Post Offices in Lobatse, Gaborone, Francistown and Selebi-Pikwe respectively.
