**UNITED KINGDOM TRADE MARKS (AMENDMENT) NOTICE, 1973**

(Published on the 21st December, 1973)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 12 as read with section 1 of the United Kingdom Trade Marks Proclamation, the Registrar of Trade Marks hereby gives notice as follows —

Citation           **1.** This Notice may be cited as the United Kingdom Trade Marks (Amendment) Notice, 1973.

Substitution of Second Schedule to Cap. 154       **2.** The United Kingdom Trade Marks Proclamation is amended by substituting for the Second Schedule the following new Schedule —

1. For Registration of Trade Mark	15,00
2. On renewal of registration and when and as often as renewal is necessary in the United Kingdom	10,00
3. On registration of any assignment, amendment, extension or registered user or cancellation or variation of any such registration	5,00
4. For cancelling the registration of trade mark or registered user thereunder either wholly or as regards any particular goods in respect of which the trade mark or registered user is registered	4,00
5. On restoration of trade mark	5,00
6. For entering in the register any change in the name, description or address of the person who is registered as proprietor or user of a trade mark	3,00
7. On registration of altered address or address of service or trade mark	3,00
8. On issue of a Certificate of registration to be used in legal proceedings or other specified purpose	5,00
9. For every entry in the register or a rectification thereof, or an alteration therein, not otherwise charged	3,00
10. On inspecting the register	
(a) by applicant	flat) 1,50
(b) by official	rate) 2,00
11. For copies of extract including certification, for every hundred words or part thereof 50 cents with a minimum of	5,00

Provided that any person engaged in research work of an historical character or of general public interest may be permitted, subject to such conditions as the Registrar may stipulate, to inspect the records and registers or to make copies of any Certificate or other document free of the payment of any fees."
