An Act to amend the Schedule to the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) Act, 1965

Date of Assent: 9.12.74

Date of Commencement: 1.11.73

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 1974, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st November, 1973.

2. Paragraph 4 of the Schedule to the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act"), is amended —

(a) in subparagraph (a) thereof, by inserting in their appropriate positions the following new entries —

"Gaborone
Ramotswa";

(b) in subparagraph (b) thereof—

(i) by substituting for the entry "Francistown and Tati East", which appears therein, the entry "Francistown";

- (ii) by substituting for the entry "Molepolole East", which appears therein, the entry "Kweneng East"; and
- (iii) by deleting the entry "Gaborone and Ramotswa", which appears therein; and
- (c) in subparagraph (c) thereof, by substituting for the entry "Tati West", which appears therein, the entry "North East".

3. The Schedule to the principal Act is amended by revoking paragraph 6 (4) thereof.

4. The Schedule to the principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the new paragraph following —

“Other allow-
ances for
Ministers and
Assistant
Ministers
9. Ministers and Assistant Ministers shall receive such housing, transport, entertainment allowances and other benefits as the President may from time to time determine.”.

5. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1 of this Act and section 1 of the National Assembly (Salaries and Allowances) (Amendment) Act, 1973, the termination allowance payable under paragraph 6 of the Schedule to the principal Act shall be payable to every person who has been a Member at any time since 1st March, 1965.

(2) In the case of a person who died while a Member or who died after ceasing to be a Member, the termination allowance shall be payable to such person's estate :

Provided that where Government has made an *ex gratia* payment to the dependants of a deceased Member, the termination allowance shall be reduced by an amount equal to such *ex gratia* payment.
