CASINO (DEEMED GAMING EXPENSES) REGULATIONS, 1974
(Published on the 17th May, 1974)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 35 of the Casino Act, 1971, the Minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Regulations -

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Casino (Deemed Gaming Expenses) Regulations, 1974, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 10th August, 1972. Citation and commencement

2. In respect of Casino Control Board Licence No. 1 and any licence replacing, amending or revising such licence, granted and issued by the Casino Control Board to Holiday Inns International (Proprietary) Ltd., for the purpose of determining the amount of any licence levy payable by the licensee under section 23 of the Act, net gaming revenue shall be calculated on the basis that deemed gaming expenses shall include any sums paid, or payable, as licence fees under section 22 of the Act.
