CONTROL OF GOODS (AUTHORIZED OFFICERS) REGULATIONS, 1974

(Published on the 3rd May, 1974)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 (2) of the Control of Goods Act, 1973, the Minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Regulations—

| Citation | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Authorized Officers) Regulations, 1974. |
| Inter-pretation | 2. In these Regulations unless the context otherwise require "authorized officer" means a person appointed by the Minister as such under regulation 3. |
| Power to appoint authorized officers | 3. For the purpose of securing compliance with regulations made under the Act, the Minister may appoint such persons as may appear to him necessary or expedient for such purpose to be authorized officers. |
| Powers of authorized officers | 4. Authorized officers shall have the power to —
(a) enter into and inspect premises to which regulations made under the Act apply; and
(b) require persons carrying on or employed in connexion with any trade, business, undertaking or enterprise to produce books, accounts or other documents relating to that trade, business, undertaking or enterprise. |
| Offence | 5. Anybody who obstructs an authorized officer in the exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 4 shall be guilty of an offence. |
