**CONTROL OF GOODS (PETROLEUM PRICES) (NO. 2) (AMENDMENT)  
(NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 1974**

*(Published on the 9th August, 1974)*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Control of Goods Act, 1973, the Minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Regulations—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Petroleum Prices) (No. 2) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1974.

2. Regulation 2 of the Control of Goods (Petroleum Prices) (No. 2) Regulations, 1974, is amended by substituting for subregulation (2) thereof the following new subregulation —

(2) No person shall sell by retail either in person or through an agent, servant or employee, at the places specified in the first column of the Schedule, illuminating paraffin, —

(a) in quantities of more than 750 ml., at a price exceeding the price per litre respectively specified in sub-column (a) of the fourth column of the Schedule; or

(b) in quantities of 750 ml., or less at a price exceeding the price per 750 ml. respectively specified in sub-column (b) of the said fourth column.”
