SECOND SCHEDULE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Control of Goods Act, 1973, the Minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Sugar Citation Prices) Regulations, 1974.
2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, "sugar" means refined white sugar, manufacturer's brown sugar and sunsweet sugar. Inter-pretation
3. Where sugar is sold, offered or exposed for sale, by retail, wrapped or in a bag or container, such wrapper, bag or container shall be clearly marked on the outer surface with — Prepacked sugar to be marked
  - (a) the weight of the sugar therein contained expressed in kilograms; and
  - (b) the price of the sugar therein contained.
4. No person shall sell, offer or expose for sale, by wholesale, either in person or through an agent, servant or employee, sugar at a price exceeding the prices respectively specified in the First Schedule. Wholesale price of sugar
5. No person shall sell, by retail, offer, or expose for sale, at the places specified in the first column of the Second Schedule, either in person or through an agent, servant or employee, sugar at a price exceeding the prices respectively specified in the second column of the said Schedule. Retail prices of sugar
6. (1) Any person carrying on any business which includes the sale of sugar, whether by wholesale or retail, shall keep proper books and accounts relating to the purchase and sale of sugar by him. Books, accounts, etc. to be kept and retained
  - (2) The books and accounts referred to in subregulation (1) and all invoices and other documents relating to the purchase and sale of sugar shall be retained in the possession of the person carrying on such business for a period of twelve months after the transactions to which they relate.

7. A person required by regulation 6 to keep and retain books, accounts, invoices and other documents shall produce the same, on demand, to any person duly authorized in that behalf by the Permanent Secretary to the Minister.

8. The Price Control (Retail Sugar Prices) Regulations, 1972, are hereby revoked.

##### Retail Prices of Sugar

(a) Any place situated within a radial distance of less than 40 kilometres from any of the following railway station goods depots, namely, Francistown, Serule, Palapye, Mahalapye, Gaborone or Lobatse.	(i) Refined white sugar	
	per 50 kg	R8,70
	per 12,5 kg	R2,25
	per 2 kg	R0,36
	per 0,50 kg	R0,9

Where refined white sugar is sold in a quantity not specified above and less than 50 kg the price for such quantity shall be calculated at the rate of R0,9 per 0,50 kg:

Provided that no quantity less than 50 kg shall be sold at a price exceeding R8,70.

(ii) Manufacturer's brown sugar	
per 50 kg	R8,70

Where manufacturer's brown sugar is sold in a quantity not specified above and less than 50 kg the price for such quantity shall be calculated

at the rate of R0,9 per 0,50 kg:  
Provided that no quantity less than 50 kg shall be sold at a price exceeding R8,70.

(iii) Sunsweet sugar

per 50 kg	R7,70
per 1 kg	R0,16

Where sunsweet sugar is sold in a quantity not specified above and less than 50 kg the price for such quantity shall be calculated at the rate of R0,8 per 0,50 kg:

Provided that no quantity less than 50 kg shall be sold at a price exceeding R7,70.

(b) Any place situated a radial distance of 40 kilometres or more but less than 160 kilometres from the nearest of the following railway station goods depots to such place, namely, Francistown, Serule, Palapye, Mahalapye, Gaborone or Lobatse.

(i) Refined white sugar

per 50 kg	R9,20
per 12,5 kg	R2,50
per 12,5 kg	R2,50
per 2 kg	R0,40
per 0,50 kg	R0,10

Where refined white sugar is sold in a quantity not specified above and less than 50 kg the price for such quantity shall be calculated at the rate of R0,10 per 0,50 kg:  
Provided that no quantity less than 50 kg shall be sold at a price exceeding R9,20.

(ii) Manufacturer's brown sugar

per 50 kg	R9,20

Where manufacturer's brown sugar is sold in a quantity not specified above and less than 50 kg the price for such quantity shall be calculated at the rate of R0,10 per 0,50 kg:  
Provided that no quantity less than 50 kg shall be sold at a price exceeding R9,20.

(iii) Sunsweet Sugar

per 50 kg	R8,20
per 1 kg	R0,18

Where sunsweet sugar is sold in a quantity not specified above and less than 50 kg the price for such quantity shall be calculated at the rate of R0,9 per 0,50 kg:

Provided that no quantity less than 50 kg shall be sold at a price exceeding R8,20.

- (c) Any place situated a radial distance of 160 kilometres but less than 320 kilometres from the nearest of the following railway station goods depots to such place, namely, Francistown, Serule, Palapye, Mahalapye, Gaborone or Lobatse.

(i) Refined white sugar	
per 50 kg	R9,70
per 12,5 kg	R2,75
per 2 kg	R0,44
per 0,50 kg	R0,11

Where refined white sugar is sold in a quantity not specified above and less than 50 kg the price for such quantity shall be calculated at the rate of R0,11 per 0,50 kg:

Provided that no quantity less than 50 kg shall be sold at a price exceeding R9,70.

(ii) Manufacturer's brown sugar	
per 50 kg	R9,70

Where manufacturer's brown sugar is sold in a quantity not specified above and less than 50 kg the price for such quantity shall be calculated at R0,11 per 0,50 kg:

Provided that no quantity less than 50 kg shall be sold at a price exceeding R9,70.

(iii) Sunsweet Sugar	
per 50 kg	R8,70
per 1 kg	R0,20

Where sunsweet sugar is sold in a quantity not specified above and less than 50 kg the price for such quantity shall be calculated at the rate of R0,10 per 0,50 kg:

Provided that no quantity less than 50 kg shall be sold at a price exceeding R8,70.

(d) Any place situated a radial distance of 320 kilometres or more from all of the following railway station goods depots at Francistown, Serule, Palapye, Mahalapye, Gaborone or Lobatse.

(i) Refined white sugar  
per 50 kg R10,20  
per 12,5 kg R3,00  
per 2 kg R0,48  
per 0,50 kg R0,12

Where refined white sugar is sold in a quantity not specified above and less than 50 kg the price for such quantity shall be calculated at R0,12 per 0,50 kg:

Provided that no quantity less than 50 kg shall be sold at a price exceeding R10,20.

(ii) Manufacturer's brown sugar  
per 50 kg R10,20

Where manufacturer's brown sugar is sold in a quantity not specified above and less than 50 kg the price for such quantity shall be calculated at the rate of R0,12 per 0,50 kg:

Provided that no quantity less than 50 kg shall be sold at a price exceeding R10,20.

(iii) Sunsweet sugar  
per 50 kg R9,20  
per 0,50 kg R0,11

Where sunsweet sugar is sold in a quantity not specified above and less than 50 kg the price for such quantity shall be calculated at the rate of R0,11 per 0,50 kg:

Provided that no quantity less than 50 kg shall be sold at a price exceeding R9,20.
