**CONTROL OF GOODS (TRADING MARGINS) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 1974**

(Published on the 25th October, 1974)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Control of Goods Act, 1973, the Minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Regulations—

Citation **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Trading Margins) (Amendment) Regulations, 1974.

Amendment of S.I. 126 of 1974 **2.** Regulation 2 of the Control of Goods (Trading Margins) Regulations, 1974, is amended by substituting for the definition of “retailer”, which appears therein, the following new definition —

“ “retailer” means —

- (a) a person who holds or is required to hold a Bottle Store Licence under the provisions of the Liquor Proclamation, 1960;
- 69 of 1960 (b) a person who, being the holder of, or being required to hold, an Hotel Liquor Licence under the provisions of the Liquor Proclamation, 1960, sells liquor in an off-sales department as defined in that Proclamation;
- 6 of 1966 (c) a person who holds or is required to hold a licence under the Trading Act, 1966, other than an agent, an auctioneer, a banker, a driller, an external representative, an insurance agent, a produce buyer or a wholesaler licence;”.
