FAUNA CONSERVATION PROCLAMATION, 1961
(22 of 1961)

DECLARATION OF MAIKAELELO GAME RESERVE

(Published on the 22nd November, 1974)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 6 (a) of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961, His Excellency the President hereby declares the area of land described in the Schedule to be a game reserve in respect of all animals and to be known as the Maikaelelo Game Reserve

SCHEDULE

Commencing at a point on the eastern boundary of the Chobe National Park, which point being approximately 44.5 km. north of the south-east corner of the said Park, the boundary runs along the following approximate bearings and distances: northwards along the eastern boundary of the Chobe National Park on an approximate bearing of 188° for approximately 14 km; thence continuing northwards along the eastern boundary of the Chobe National Park on an approximate bearing of 213° for approximately 12 km; thence eastwards for approximately 18.5 km. to a point on the eastern tip of an elongated hill or sand ridge; thence southwards for approximately 7.5 km. to a point on the track from Kachikau to Gehumdi; thence generally eastwards along the said track for approximately 7.5 km; thence in a south south-westerly direction on an approximate bearing of 25° for approximately 19 km. to a point on a cattle drive route track which runs generally from north to south; thence generally northwards along the said track for approximately 5 km; thence westwards for approximately 23 km. to the point of commencement, as will more fully appear on Plan BP-179 filed in the Department of Surveys and Lands, Gaborone.
