SCHEDULE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by regulation 4 of the Town Council Regulations, 1966, His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Order --

1. This Order may be cited as the Establishment of Selebi-Pikwe Township Order, 1974.

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires --  
"appointed day" means the 26th October, 1974.

"Council" means the Selebi-Pikwe Town Council established by paragraph 3 (1).

3. (1) With effect from the appointed day there shall be established a town council, to be known as the Selebi-Pikwe Town Council, in respect of the area specified in the Declaration of Selebi-Pikwe Township Notice, 1970.

(2) The Council shall consist of --

(a) 6 members who shall be elected in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government (Conduct of Elections) Regulations, 1966, (hereinafter in this Order referred to as "elected members"); and

(b) 4 members appointed by the Minister by notice published in the Gazette.

4. An election may be held before the appointed day to elect the first elected members of the Council but no such elected member shall be deemed to be a member of the Council until the appointed day.

5. If the seat of a member of the Council becomes vacant, the vacancy shall be filled in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 3.

6. No person shall be deemed to possess the disqualifications specified in regulation 7 of the Regulations merely because he has applied for or has been granted a passport issued by or under the authority of the Government of any of the countries specified in the Schedule.

Functions to be performed by Council

Transfer of assets and liabilities of Township Authority S.I. 81 of 1970

**7.** The Council shall perform the functions specified in paragraph 1 of the First Schedule to the Regulations and may perform all or any of the remaining functions specified in the said Schedule.

**8.** On the appointed day —

- (a) the Selebi-Pikwe Township Authority established under the Selebi-Pikwe Township Regulations, 1970, is dissolved;
- (b) all the assets and liabilities, whatsoever and wheresoever situate, of the Selebi-Pikwe Township Authority shall, by virtue of this Order and without further formality, be transferred to and vested in the Council; and
- (c) the Selebi-Pikwe Township Regulations, 1970, are revoked.
