IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by sections 12, 26, 42 and 59 of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961, the Minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Order —

Citation           **1.** This Order may be cited as the Fauna Conservation (Amendment of Schedules) Order, 1974, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 13th March, 1974.

Amendment of Second Schedule to Proclamation 22 of 1961       **2.** (1) Part I of the Second Schedule to the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Proclamation) is amended in column I thereof by inserting in its correct alphabetical order the entry —

“Roan Antelope”.

(2) Part II of Second Schedule to the principal Proclamation is amended in the first column thereof —

(a) by deleting the entry “Roan Antelope”; and

(b) by including therein in its correct alphabetical order, the new entry—

“Leopard”.

Amendment of Third Schedule to principal Proclamation       **3.** (1) The Third Schedule to the principal Proclamation is amended by substituting for Part B thereof the following new Part —

**Licence Fees and Periods**

*Periods*

A bird licence issued to a resident shall be issued for a year, commencing with the day of issue.

A bird licence issued to a non-resident may be issued for one week, 1 month or 1 year, commencing with the day issue.

A general game licence shall be issued for a season. No person shall be issued with more than one season general game licence in any one season.
