**FAUNA CONSERVATION (BAKWENA TRIBAL TERRITORY)
HUNTING (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1974**

(Published on the 10th May, 1974)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 93, as read with section 4, of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961, the Minister of Commerce and Industry, after consultation with the Chief of the Bakwena Tribal Territory and the Kweneng District Council, hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fauna Conservation (Bakwena Tribal Territory) Hunting (Amendment) Regulations, 1974. Citation

2. Part II of the First Schedule to the Fauna Conservation (Bakwena Tribal Territory) Hunting Regulations, 1968, (hereinafter called "the principal Regulations"), is amended by adding at the end thereof the following new item. Amendment of Part II of First Schedule to S.I. 37 of 1968

3. The principal Regulations are amended by substituting for the Second and Third Schedules thereto the following new Schedules — Substitution of Second and Third Schedules
