FAUNA CONSERVATION PROCLAMATION, 1961
(22 of 1961)

FAUNA CONSERVATION (DRIVER/COURIERS) REGULATIONS, 1974
(Published on the 14th June, 1974)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 93 of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961, the Minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Regulations -

- Citation **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Fauna Conservation (Driver/Couriers) Regulations, 1974.
- Inter-pretation **2.** In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires -
“authorized officer” means the Director or any game officer deputed by the Director in writing to be an authorized officer for the purposes of these Regulations;
“Director” means the Director of Wildlife and National Parks;
“driver/courier” means any person who, for hire or reward, conducts any party of people in a motor vehicle or boat for the purposes of photographing or viewing animals, and includes the driver of a motor vehicle or boat containing such a party.
- Driver/couriers to be authorized **3.** (1) No person shall act as a driver/courier unless he is authorized in writing in that behalf by an authorized officer.
(2) Any person who contravenes the provisions of this regulation shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of R100 and to imprisonment for 3 months.
