ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation

2. Amendment of the Fauna Conservation (General) Regulations, 1968

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 93 (2) of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961, the Minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fauna Conservation (General) Citation
(Amendment) Regulations, 1974, and shall be deemed to have come into
operation on the 13th March, 1974.

2. The Fauna Conservation (General Regulations, 1968 are amended — Amendment
of S.I.

(a) by repealing regulations 3, 4, 5 and 7 thereof;

(b) by substituting for Forms B, C, D and O in the First Schedule
thereto the following new forms —

C. In terms of section 64 of the Proclamation licence is granted to the person named above to export the game skins, trophies and meat obtained under the above licence.
