ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by regulation 31 as read with regulation 32 of the Town Council Regulations, 1966, the Francistown Town Council, with the approval of the Minister of Local Government and Lands, hereby make the following Bye-Laws —

| Citation | 1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Francistown (Annual and Supplementary) Rating Bye-Laws, 1974. |
| Levy of Rates | 2. (1) The following rates are levied in respect of the period 1st January, 1973, to 31st December, 1973 —
<i>(a)</i> a rate of one cent in the rand in respect of all improved rateable land within Francistown Township;
<i>(b)</i> a rate of two cents in the rand in respect of all unimproved rateable land within Francistown Township.
(2) The following rates shall be levied in respect of the period 1st January, 1974 to 31st March, 1974 —
<i>(a)</i> a rate of 0,25 cents in the rand in respect of all improved rateable land within Francistown Township;
<i>(b)</i> a rate of 0,50 cents in the rand in respect of all unimproved rateable land in Francistown Township. |
| When rates due and payable | 3. The rates fixed in bye-law 2 shall become due and payable by the owner on the 8th April, 1974. |
