INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT (PROTECTION) (NO. 2) ORDER, 1974

(Published on the 6th September, 1974)

WHEREAS Air Cushion Vehicles Botswana (Pty) Ltd. has asked for protection in terms of the Industrial Development Act, 1968;

AND WHEREAS the Minister of Commerce and Industry has decided to grant a Licence under section 11 of the said Act, and has granted a licence, namely, Industrial Licence No. 159 dated 20th June, 1974;

AND WHEREAS His Excellency the President has decided that it is in the public interest and in the interests of the efficient development of the industry concerned that protection be granted;

NOW THEREFORE IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 12 of the Industrial Development Act, 1968. His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Order —

1. This Order may be cited as the Industrial Development (Protection) (No. 2) Order, 1974.

2. The manufacture of air cushion vehicles of all types and products or parts thereof throughout Botswana by any person other than Air Cushion Vehicles Botswana (Pty.) Ltd. is hereby excluded for a period of 4 years with effect from the 20th June, 1974.
