**MAUN WATERWORKS AREA DECLARATION, 1974**

*(Published on the 12th July, 1974)*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by sections 3 and 4 of the Waterworks Law, 1961, the Minister of Mineral Resources and Water Affairs hereby declares as follows --

1. This Declaration may be cited as the Maun Waterworks Area Citation Declaration, 1974.

2. Maun Village, being an area in which an undertaking exists, is declared to be a waterworks area, the boundaries of which are defined in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Commencing at a point in the middle of the Maun/Nata main road, which point being approximately 670 metres along the said road west of the middle of the road bridge across the Thamalakane River, the boundary runs along the following approximate bearing and distances: generally south-westwards on an approximate bearing of  $44^{\circ}30'$  for a approximately 1000 metres; thence continuing in a south-westerly direction along the line of the high flood level on the right bank of the Thamalakane River for approximately 610 metres; thence westwards on an approximate bearing of  $89^{\circ}30'$  for approximately 140 metres; thence in a north-westerly direction on a bearing of  $137^{\circ}00'$  for approximately 965 metres; thence in a north-easterly direction on a bearing of  $217^{\circ}00'$  for approximately 1000 metres; thence in a north-westerly direction on a bearing of  $121^{\circ}00'$  for approximately 535 metres; thence due north on a bearing of  $180^{\circ}00'$  for approximately 1370 metres; thence in a north-easterly direction on an approximate bearing of  $246^{\circ}00'$  for approximately 3310 metres; thence in a south-easterly direction on a bearing of  $330^{\circ}00'$  for approximately 920 metres to its intersection with the high flood level line on the right bank of the Thamalakane River; thence following the said high flood level line in a south-westerly direction for approximately 2800 metres to a point north-east of the point of commencement; thence in a south-westerly direction on an approximate bearing of  $62^{\circ}00'$  for approximately 610 metres to the point of commencement as will more fully appear on the deposited copy of Plan PM-11 filed in the Department of Surveys and Lands, Gaborone.
