PUBLIC SERVICE (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1974

(Published on the 25th January, 1974)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 35 of the Public Service Act, 1973, His Excellency the President has made the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Service (Amendment) Regulations, 1974. Citation

2. Regulation 23 of the Public Service Regulations, 1970 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), is amended — Amendment
of regulation
23 of S.I. 57
of 1970

(a) in paragraph (1) thereof, by inserting immediately after the word "proceedings", where it appears therein, the expression "and the responsible officer may treat such record for all purposes as the report of a preliminary investigation held under regulation 17"; and

(b) by substituting for paragraph (2) thereof the following new paragraph —

"(2) If an officer has been convicted of a criminal offence for which he has been sentenced to a term of imprisonment without the option of a fine, or has been convicted of a criminal offence under any written law where a sentence of imprisonment may be imposed otherwise than in default of payment of a fine, the responsible officer may, upon production of a certified copy of the criminal proceedings, dismiss the officer without instituting disciplinary proceedings against him."

3. Regulation 35 (1) of the principal Regulations is amended by adding, at the end thereof, a new sentence as follows — Amendment
of regulation
35 of the
principal
Regulations

"The members appointed by the Association shall be appointed after the members appointed by the Minister and the Association shall not appoint any person to be a member who has been so appointed by the Minister."
