ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1974

(Published on the 20th December, 1974)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 127 of the Road Traffic Act, 1972, the Minister of Works and Communications hereby makes the following Regulations ---

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1974.

2. Regulation 9 of the Road Traffic Regulations, 1974, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations), is amended by inserting immediately after the words "commercial vehicles", which appear in paragraph (b) thereof, the words "and trailers used in connexion therewith".

3. Regulation 67 of the principal Regulations is amended by substituting for subregulation (3) thereof the new subregulation following ---

"(3) The warning sign referred to in subregulation (2) shall consist of either ---

(a) alternate diagonal strips of red reflective and yellow non-reflective material in the form of a chevron pattern as illustrated in Part A of the Sixth Schedule; or

(b) not less than 7 nor more than 11 red retro-reflector each with a reflecting area of not less than 10 cm² set in two lines in the manner illustrated in Part B of the Sixth Schedule."

4. Paragraph 3 (c) of the First Schedule to the principal Regulations, which relates to motor dealer's licence, is amended by substituting for the figure "40,00", which appears in the third column, the figure "10,00".

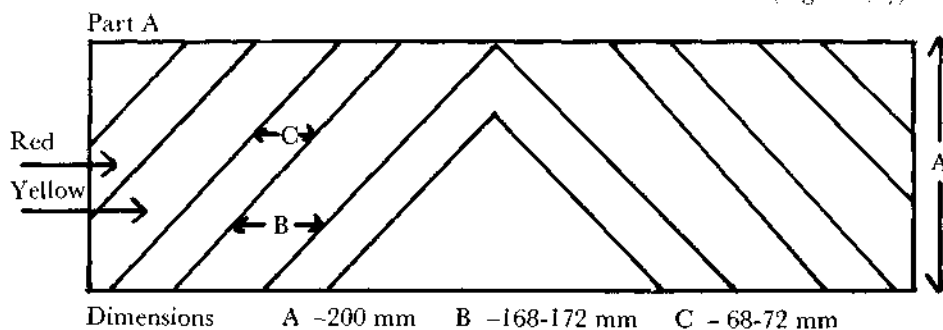
5. The principal Regulations are amended by substituting for the Sixth Schedule the new Schedule following ---

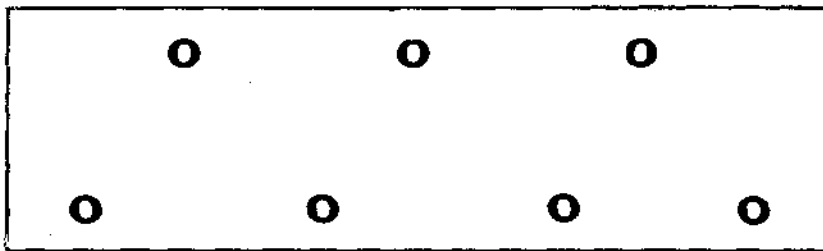
