**ROAD TRAFFIC (MOTOR CYCLES) (PROTECTIVE HELMETS)
REGULATIONS, 1974**

(Published on the 27th December, 1974)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 127 of the Road Traffic Act, 1972, the Minister of Works and Communications hereby makes the following Regulations

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Motor Cycles) (Protective Helmets) Regulations, 1974.
2. No person shall drive or be a passenger on a motor cycle on any road unless he is wearing a protective helmet which --- Compulsory wearing of protective helmet
 - (a) fits him properly, and of which the chin strap is properly fastened under his chin; and
 - (b) conforms to British Standard Specification 2001/1956, British Standard Specification 1869/1963 or South African Bureau of Standards No. 7799/1967.
