ROAD TRANSPORT (PERMITS) (EXEMPTION) ORDER, 1974

(Published on the 30th January, 1974)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 5 (5) of the Road Transport (Permits) Act, 1973, the Minister of Works and Communications hereby makes the following Order —

Citation **1.** This Order may be cited as the Road Transport (Permits) (Exemption) Order, 1974.

Exemption of certain motor vehicles **2.** The motor vehicles specified in the Schedule are hereby exempted from the provisions of the Act.

SCHEDULE

1. Motor vehicles owned and operated by a local authority.
2. Motor vehicles owned and operated by Rhodesia Railways for the purpose of maintaining track and rolling stock.
3. Vehicles owned and operated by the Governments of Lesotho, Swaziland, Zambia and South Africa.
4. Vehicles registered for the use of diplomatic missions and personnel.
