ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

SECTION

1. Short title
2. Amendment of section 3 of Cap. 03:06

An Act to provide that the President shall be obliged to award an Honour if a motion is passed by a Simple Majority in the National Assembly calling upon him so to do

Date of Assent: 18.12.75

Date of Commencement: 31.12.75

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the Botswana Honours (Amendment) Act, 1975. Short title

2. Section 3 of the Botswana Honours Act is amended by substituting therefor the new section following — Amendment of section 3 of Cap. 03:06

“3. Honours shall be awarded by the President —

- (a) on such occasions and to such persons as he may determine; or —
- (b) in accordance with any motion passed by a simple majority in the National Assembly calling upon him so to do.”
