1. Short title
2. Amendment of section 21 of Law 19 of 1966

**An Act to amend the Immigration (Consolidation) Law, 1966**

*Date of Assent:* 18.12.75

*Date of Commencement:* 31.12.75

**ENACTED** by the Parliament of Botswana.

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Immigration (Consolidation) (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 1975. Short title

**2.** Section 21 of the Immigration (Consolidation) Law, 1966, is amended by adding the new subsection following – Amendment of section 21 of Law 19 of 1966

“ (11) If the Minister is satisfied that by reason of any special circumstances which apply in the case of any person who has entered Botswana and who is not a prohibited immigrant it is desirable for a residence permit to be issued to such person without an application therefor being considered by the Board, he may, notwithstanding the preceding provisions of this section, and whether or not such person has applied for a residence permit, issue a residence permit to that person.”
