5. The Interpretation and General Provisions Act is amended by inserting, immediately after section 18 thereof, the new section following ---

"Signification
of Assent and
original
copies of Acts

18A. (1) The President shall signify that he assents to a Bill by signing each of four copies of such Bill, which shall, upon such signature, become an Act.

(2) Each of the four copies of an Act signed in accordance with subsection (1) shall be deemed to be an original copy of such Act and shall be conclusive evidence of the terms of the Act, its number and the date of assent.

(3) One of the original copies of each Act shall be retained by the President who shall cause one each of the remaining copies to be deposited with the Speaker of the National Assembly and the Chief Justice, and one deposited in the Government Archives."
