**CONTROL OF GOODS (TRADING MARGINS) (NO. 2)  
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1975**  
(Published on the 12th December, 1975)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Control of Goods Act, 1973, the Minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Regulations –

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Trading Margins) (No. 2) (Amendment) Regulations, 1975. Citation

2. Regulation 2 of the Control of Goods (Trading Margins) (No. 2) Regulations, 1974, (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Regulations”), is amended by inserting immediately after the word “discounts”, which appears in the definition of “cost price”, the words “, not exceeding ten per centum *in toto*,”. Amendment of regulation 2 of S.I. 146 of 1974

3. The Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended –

- (a) by substituting for the figure “7½%”, wherever it appears in the second column of the said Schedule, the figure “10%”; Amendment of Schedule to principal Regulations
- (b) by substituting for the figure “6%”, which appears in the third column of the said Schedule and in respect of paragraph 1. (a), the figure “7½%” ;
- (c) by deleting paragraph 3 (d) thereof; and
- (d) by inserting at the end thereof the new paragraph following –

4. (a) New household furniture and other goods normally sold through furniture shops and not specifically mentioned elsewhere .....	10%	50%
(b) Second-hand furniture and other goods normally sold through furniture shops and not specifically mentioned elsewhere .....	5%	35%
(c) All other goods not specifically mentioned in this Schedule .....	10%	33½%”
