COURT OF APPEAL (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1975

(Published on the 10th October, 1975)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 16 of the Court of Appeal Act, the President of the Court of Appeal hereby makes the following Rules —

1. These Rules may be cited as the Court of Appeal (Amendment) Rules, 1975.

2. Rule 40 (1) of the Court of Appeal Rules, 1975, is amended as follows —

(a) by the deletion of subparagraph (b) thereof and substituting therefor the following —

“(b) the judgment of the lower court and, if the President or a Judge of the High Court so directs, the record of the proceedings in the lower court as submitted to the High Court;” and

(b) by the deletion of subparagraph (d) thereof and substituting therefor the following —

“(d) the Judge’s notes of any evidence taken on the hearing of the appeal:

Provided that, if shorthand notes or tape or other recording has been taken, a copy of the transcript thereof shall be included, either in addition to or in substitution of the Judge’s notes, as he may direct;”.
