**DECLARATION OF PRECIOUS STONE SECURITY AREA
LETLHAKANE MINE**

(Published on the 24th December, 1975)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 26 (1) of the Precious Stones Industry (Protection) Act, the Minister of Mineral Resources and Water Affairs, with the consent of the holder of the mining right concerned, hereby declares the area specified in the Schedule to be a precious stone security area.

S.I. 135 The Precious Stones Security Area (DK1-DK2) Order, 1975, is hereby
of 1974 revoked.

SCHEDULE

Commencing at a point A the co-ordinates of which are Y - 70300,15 X + 2379420,04 the boundary runs in a straight line in an easterly direction to a point B the co-ordinates of which are Y - 72899,86 and X + 2379 419,93; thence in a straight line in a southerly direction to a point C the co-ordinates of which are Y - 72 900,47 and X + 2 382 219,89; thence in a straight line in a westerly direction to a point D the co-ordinates of which are Y - 70 300,20 X + 2 382 220,13; thence in a northerly direction to the point of commencement, as will more fully appear from Plan NO-5, filed in the Department of Surveys and Lands, the co-ordinates of points A, B, C and D being expressed in metres on the Trigonometrical system Lo 25.
