**FAUNA CONSERVATION (BANGWAKETSE TRIBAL TERRITORY)
HUNTING (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1975**

(Published on the 27th March, 1975)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 93 of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961, after consultation with District Council the appropriate the minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Regulations —

Citation and application **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Fauna Conservation (Bangwaketse Tribal Territory) Hunting (Amendment) Regulations, 1975.

Amendment of regulation 4 of S.I. 56 of 1968 **2.** The Fauna Conservation (Bangwaketse Tribal Territory) Hunting Regulations, 1968, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations) is amended by substituting for subregulation (1) thereof the new subregulation following —

“(1) Subject to the provisions of regulations 7, 10 and 11, no member shall hunt tribally protected game without being in possession of a licence permitting him to do so and —

(a) no member shall be granted a licence permitting him to hunt tribally game in excess of the number prescribed in the second column of Part II of the First Schedule; and

(b) the maximum number of tribally protected game permitted in all licences in any one hunting season shall not exceed that prescribed in the third column of Part II of the First Schedule.”.

Amendment of First Schedule of the principal Regulations **3.** The First Schedule of the principal Regulations is amended by substituting for Part II thereof the new Part II following —

Amendment of Third Schedule of principal Regulations **4.** The principal Regulations are amended by substituting for the Third Schedule thereto the new Schedule following —

“THIRD SCHEDULE (regulation 9)

Licence Fees

(a) In the case of Tribally Protected Game

(i) Lion (Tau) R20,00

- (ii) Leopard (Nkwe) R20,00
- (iii) Gemsbok (Kukama) R 5,00

(b) In the case of Tribally Protected Game listed in Part II B of the First Schedule R1,00

(c) In the case of Tribally Protected Game listed in the Second Schedule R3,00".
