GABORONE DAM NATIONAL PARK ORDER, 1975
(Published on the 21st November, 1975)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 of the National Parks Act, 1967, His Excellency the President has made the following Order -

1. This Order may be cited as the Gaborone Dam National Park Order, Citation 1975.
2. The area of State Land described in the Schedule hereto is constituted as a national park and is named Gaborone Dam National Park. Constitution of national park

SCHEDULE

Commencing at point "A" the boundary runs north-eastwards on an approximate bearing of 229° for approximately 1 610 metres to point "B"; thence south-eastwards on an approximate bearing of 318° for approximately 1 025 metres to point "C", being a point on the northern boundary of Lot 4836, Gaborone; thence following the northern boundary of Lot 4836, Gaborone, on a bearing of 109° 06' 20" for approximately 400 metres to point "D", being a 20 mm iron peg in concrete; thence south-westwards along the northern boundary of Lot 4836, Gaborone, on a bearing of 40° 10' 30" for approximately 1 365 metres to point "E"; thence north-westwards on an approximate bearing of 134° for approximately 860 metres to the point of commencement, as will more fully appear on Plan RO-225 filed in the Department of Surveys and Lands, Gaborone.
