**HIGH COURT (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1975**

*(Published on the 27th June, 1975)*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 28 of the High Court of Botswana Act, 1967, the Chief Justice hereby makes the following Rules —

1. These Rules may be cited as the High Court (Amendment) Rules, 1975, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st August, 1974.

Citation and commencement

2. The Rules of the High Court are amended by substituting for Order 57 thereof the new Order following —

Amendment of Rules of the High Court S.I. 117 of 1969

ORDER 57

“ ALLOWANCES PAYABLE TO ASSESSORS

1. An assessor shall be paid for every day or part thereof necessarily spent away from his normal place of residence for the purpose of attendance at court a fee of R15.
2. An assessor shall also be reimbursed his reasonable transport costs from his normal place of residence to the court.
3. Where in the opinion of the Registrar payment of the allowances prescribed in this Order would cause undue hardship, or there are extraordinary circumstances in any particular instance calling for special allowances to be paid, he may authorize the payment of such additional allowances as he may deem appropriate.”
