NOTICE OF ADOPTION BY SOUTHERN DISTRICT COUNCIL

(Published on the 23rd May, 1975)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 36 of the Local Government (District Councils) Law, 1965, the Southern District Council has adopted the Control of Boreholes (Model) Bye-Laws, 1968, in whole and without variation as bye-laws of the District Council to be in force within its area of jurisdiction with effect from the date of publication of this Instrument.

2. The fees payable shall be those specified in the First Schedule hereto.

3. The Bye-Laws shall apply to those boreholes listed and numbered in the Second Schedule hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE

- (a) Water for domestic purposes under Bye-Law 3.....fee
R1,00 per annum per Lolwapa or 10c per month per Lolwapa.
- (b) Stock registered under Bye-Law 4 —
- (i) Cattle per head per month 10c
 - (ii) Donkey per head per month 10c
 - (iii) 7 goats/sheep per month 10c
- (c) Stock watering under provision of Bye-Law 7 per head per day.
