**PRISONS (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 1975**

*(Published on the 30th May, 1975)*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 107 of the Prisons Law, 1964, His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Regulations —

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Prisons (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1975.

The Fourth Schedule to the Prisons Regulations, 1965, is amended —

- (a) by adding the words "single silver band on peak of cap" immediately after the words "Crest over 1 star on shoulder straps", which appear therein; and
- (b) by substituting for the words "Matron Head Warder", which appear therein, the words "Matron and Head Warder".
