**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (ENFORCEMENT NOTICE)  
REGULATIONS, 1975**

(Published on the 31st October, 1975)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 26 of the Town and Country Planning Proclamation, 1961, the Minister of Local Government and Lands hereby makes the following Regulations

1. These Regulations may be cited as the 'Town and Country Planning (Enforcement Notice) Regulations, 1975.

2. The form set out in the Schedule hereto shall be used for the purpose of the Proclamation to which it applies.

ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

WHEREAS you are erecting or have erected a new development consisting of.....

which is situate within an area to which an Order for a Town Planning Scheme applies, without the permission of the.....  
(local authority) and the Minister:

NOW THEREFORE I hereby require you within 28 days from receipt of this notice to - -

- (a) demolish the construction;
- (b) alter the construction in the following manner -

- (c) discontinue your construction, building or other operations.

Should you fail to take such steps as are specified in the above notice the provisions of sections 25C or 25D of the Proclamation may be brought into effect.
