CIVIL AVIATION (APPLICATION OF ACT) ORDER, 1951

**AIR TRANSPORT (TEMPORARY AIR SERVICE PERMITS)
REGULATIONS, 1976**

(Published on 3rd September, 1976)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Civil Aviation Act, 1949, His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Regulations —

Citation and
commence-
ment **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Air Transport (Temporary
Air Service Permits) Regulations, 1976, and shall come into operation on
1st October, 1976.

Inter-
pretation **2.** In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, "tempor-
ary air service" means any service performed by any aircraft, other than a
scheduled service, for hire or reward:

Provided that a member of a club carried in an aircraft belonging to
that club for the purposes of instruction shall not, if the instructor is also a
member of the club, be deemed to be carried for hire or reward, notwith-
standing that payment is made for such instruction or carriage.

Temporary
air service
permits **3.** (1) A person operating a temporary air service in an aircraft not
registered in Botswana from a place outside Botswana to a place in Botswana
shall apply to the Director of Civil Aviation for a temporary air service
permit giving in his application the information set out in the Schedule.

(2) The fee payable shall be calculated at the rate of P2,00 per seat,
other than the pilot's seat, in the aircraft.

SCHEDULE

(reg. 3 (1))

INFORMATION REQUIRED

1. Operator's name and address.
2. Aircraft type, registration and flight number.
3. Date and time of departure on journey to Botswana, route and
estimated time of arrival at destination.
4. Date and time of departure from Botswana, route and destination.
5. Name of captain.
6. General nature of freight, and weight.
7. Number and nationality of passengers.
8. Name of charterers.
