**AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULES (NO. 24) NOTICE, 1976**

*(Published on 17th September, 1976)*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by sections 49 and 50 of the Customs and Excise Duty Act, the Minister of Finance and Development Planning hereby amends, with effect from 23rd August, 1976, the Schedules to the Act to the extent set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

1. All Schedules (other than Schedule No. 8). Any reference in any Schedule to a specified number of cents shall be deemed to be a reference to the equivalent number of units of account calculated at the rate of one unit of account to every hundred cents.
2. Note I of the General Notes to Schedule No. 1 is amended by inserting, in its appropriate alphabetical order, the new entry following ---  
UA means unit of account
3. Note II, of the General Notes to Schedule No. 1 is amended by inserting, immediately after paragraph (7) thereof, the new paragraph following --  
(8) The unit of account by reference to which certain specific duties are expressed or the scope of certain headings or subheadings is defined shall be deemed to be equal to a unit of the currency in circulation in the remainder of the common customs area.
