COMPANIES (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1976

(Published on the 26th March, 1976)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 313 of the Companies Act, the Minister of Commerce and Industry hereby makes the following Order —

1. This Order may be cited as the Companies (Amendment) Order, 1976, and shall come into operation on 1st April, 1976.

2. Paragraph 1. A. of the First Table in the Seventh Schedule to the Companies Act is amended by substituting therefor the new paragraph following —
